



Learning from fires in Norway

The important post-extinguishing work

FRIC have written a report on how Norway can learn better from fires. Knowledge from fires can save lives and we present six key recommendations:

- Increase resources for fire investigation and prioritisation of fire preventive work.
- Establish a national investigation committee for severe incidents regarding fire.
- Formalise regional investigation groups for much needed cooperation and quality.
- Increase education, training and competence for several actors involved in fire investigation.
- Establish guidelines for cooperation and sharing of knowledge internally in the fire service (preparedness + preventive), and between fire service and municipality.
- Common terminology and methodology for easier cooperation between fire investigation actors.

6 recommendations that we think will strengthen Norway's capacity to investigate fires, learn from them and make changes.

This way we'll make a safer society for people and assets!
